No power supply

Infant undergoes cataract surgery

A cataract operation was performed on a four-month baby boy after a dense total cataract was detected in both eyes, on Friday. The operation was done by Dr Arun Samprathi at Samprathi Eye Hospital and Squint Centre on August 18. Mrs Bhagyalakshmi's baby was diagnosed with cataract. The baby failed to focus like normal four-month infant.

A microsurgery for a procedure called primary posterior capsulotomy was done. Since the child's eye was very small, an intraocular implant was not performed. He will need glasses or contact lenses to correct his vision and should be able to gain reasonably good vision, said Dr Samprathi.
